

Success factors for information systems projects in public organizations - insight from Poland

The main objective of the research project is to develop the critical success factors (CSF) model for information systems (IS) project in public organizations in Poland. The fulfillment of the basic objective of the project requires the implementation of cognitive, theoretical and empirical objectives. Such a way of stating the project's objective requires the implementation of specific goals of cognitive, theoretical and empirical nature. **The cognitive goals** relate primary to: (1) identification and systemizing the success factors of IS projects in business and public organizations, and (2) identification of the differences and similarities between success factors of IS projects in business and public organizations. **The theoretical goal** focuses on the development of the CSF model for IS projects in public organizations. **The empirical goal** is to verify the proposed model and to elaborate recommendations for IS projects in public organizations, and also improve existing approach to project management.
