

How to apply for the Erasmus+ scholarship. Step by step









Check regularly information about the Erasmus+ programme and organized meetings

(International Relation's website and Facebook profile)

Come to the information meeting on the Erasmus+ programme

Check the requirements and schedule of the recruitment









Take part in the **main** recruitment organized annually in March

Check if you meet requirements of the partner universities you are interested in

Check the academic offer of the universities you are interested in











If it is required, get the confirmation of your B2 level of a foreign language

Complete the online application

form, upload the required documents and choose 4 universities according to your preferences. Submit your application

Wait for the verification of your application (average grade 3.5, Dean's recommendation)













Wait for an e-mail from the International Relations with the results of selection.

Send your reply with acceptance or rejection of the assigned university If you missed the main recruitment or did not get a university of your choice you can apply again in the additional recruitment in June or October















Come to the information meeting for the qualified students

Within the deadline given by the host university the **International Relations** will send your nomination to the coordinator abroad

Send the application documents required by the host university

Start preparations for your Erasmus+ stay!
