

Annex to the Rules and Regulations for the Implementation of Mobility under the Erasmus+ Programme to Universities in the European Union and Associated Countries (mobility for studies)

Points 12 and 13 are added to Section II

12. A student with children under the age of 8 (in the year of the mobility period), who has been qualified for an Erasmus+ mobility and indicated this fact in the online application at the recruitment stage, and submits to the International Relations Office a declaration confirmed by the child's birth certificate (document to be presented to the university), will be granted additional support in the form of a lump sum of 250 euros per month.

13. A student who is a beneficiary of asylum or holds refugee status, who has been qualified for an Erasmus+ mobility and indicated this fact in the online application at the recruitment stage, and submits to the International Relations Office a declaration confirming the granted right of asylum/refugee status (documents to be presented to the university), will be granted additional support in the form of a lump sum of 250 euros per month.
