

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO SIGN AN ERASMUS+ MOBILITY AGREEMENT

Letter of Acceptance

The receiving university must confirm that it accepts the student for exchange studies in the form of a personal invitation sent by e-mail. If the confirmation does not include information about the period of stay abroad, the student is obligated to check the exact dates of the beginning and end of the period of study at a receiving university. This information is needed to calculate the amount of the Erasmus+ scholarship.

Online Learning Agreement

Study program agreement created in the OLA system (<https://learning-agreement.eu/>); a document signed by the student and representatives of both universities.

EHIC Card

The card is issued by the National Health Fund at the student's request. The form is available at: <http://www.nfz.gov.pl>. The card must be valid for the entire period of the student's stay in the country of the host university.

Private Insurance Policy

The student can purchase insurance from any insurance company offering foreign insurance. It must cover: accidents, costs of medical treatment, costs of transport to/from a medical facility and transportation of remains to home country. The policy must be valid for the entire period of the student's stay in the country of the host university. If the required components are not visible in the policy, student must additionally complete the document: Private Insurance declaration

Bank Data Form

Completed bank data form available on the International Relations website.

Travel Declaration

Based on the completed declaration, Internations Relations Office calculates the amount of support for travel costs.
