

Formal rules of qualification for mobilities within the Erasmus + programme in the academic year 2021/2022

Major, year and level of studies

You can apply within the main recruitment in March and additional recruitment in May/June if you are a student of:

- ✓ full-time or part-time studies
- ✓ 1st year of bachelor degree studies- you can apply for summer semester of the next academic year only
- ✓ 2nd year of bachelor degree studies – you can apply for winter or summer semester of the next academic year
- ✓ 3rd year of bachelor degree studies- you can apply for summer semester of the next academic year only (you need to take up master degree studies at UE Katowice) ✓ 1st year of master degree studies- you can apply for winter or summer semester of the next academic year only
- ✓ 2nd semester of 3,5-bachelor degree in Logistics (professional title of engineer)- you can apply for summer semester of the next academic year
- ✓ 4th year of 3,5-bachelor degree in Logistics (professional title of engineer)- you can apply for winter or summer semester of the next academic year
- ✓ 1st semester of 1,5- master degree in Logistics- you can apply for winter or summer semester of the next academic year

Students of the 6th semester of 3,5-bachelor degree in Logistics cannot take part in the recruitment.

You can apply within the additional recruitment in October if you are a student of:

- ✓ full-time or part-time studies
- ✓ 2nd and 3rd year of bachelor degree studies
- ✓ 1st and 2nd year of master degree studies (also graduates of bachelor degree studies of different universities)
- ✓ 3rd and 5th semester of 3,5 bachelor degree in Logistics (professional title of engineer)- you can apply for winter or summer semester of the next academic year
- ✓ 2nd semester of 1,5-master degree in Logistics

Students of the 7th semester of 3,5-bachelor degree in Logistics cannot take part in the recruitment.

Minimum average grade - 3,31

In case of all three recruitments you need to have minimum average grade of 3,31 from all the completed semesters within a particular level of studies (including the winter semester 2020/2021). The average grade is calculated by the Dean's Office.

Main recruitment in March and additional recruitment in April/May

The required average grade for students of the 1st semester of 1,5- master degree in Logistics is taken from the diploma from the previous level of studies.

Additional recruitment in October

The average grade for students of the 1st year of master degree studies is taken from the diploma from the previous level of studies.

Recommendation of the Dean

In order to be qualified for the Erasmus+ programme a student needs to receive a full or conditional recommendation of the Dean. The Dean's decision regarding the recommendation is given to the International Relations by the Dean's Office together with the average grade.

Main recruitment in March and additional recruitment in April/May

Conditional recommendation of the Dean is given to 1st year bachelor degree students, to students who have some failed courses or need to re-sit exams, to students who, during the recruitment process, are abroad realizing their mobility within the Erasmus + programme, and to 3rd year bachelor degree students until they are officially accepted for the master degree studies.

Additional recruitment in October

Students of the 1st semester of master degree studies receive a conditional recommendation (if they have successfully completed their first semester of studies)..

Approval of the BA/MA Thesis Supervisor

Students whose stay within the Erasmus+ will be on their last semester of studies need to receive an approval from their BA/MA thesis supervisor. The approval can be sent by e-mail. International Relations office asks for the supervisor's approval after the qualification of the student for the program. Students who were unable to choose a supervisor during the recruitment must send their consent as soon as possible after their selection.

Language of instruction- B2

You need to know the language of instruction of the partner university on the B2 level. If the language certificate is required by the university, you need to upload it into the system while submitting the application form. You can check the language certificate requirement in the file with the list of universities and their offer.

Previous participation in the Erasmus+ Programme

The formalities related to your previous participation in the Erasmus+ programme must be finalized, except for students staying during the recruitment at the partner university.

Applying for the Erasmus+ scholarship during your Erasmus+ stay abroad Main

recruitment in March and additional recruitment in April/May

Students staying at a partner university within the Erasmus+ mobility may apply for another Erasmus+ scholarship only for a stay in the summer semester of the next academic year. Students are advised to choose partner universities that start their summer semester after the end of the winter exam session at UE Katowice.

Additional recruitment in October

There is no possibility to take part in the recruitment during the Erasmus+ stay abroad.

Resignation from the Erasmus+ stay in previous years

If the resignation from the Erasmus+ scholarship in previous years was caused by some important personal issues (explained at the time of resignation to the International Relations in an e-mail) or by restrictions caused by covid-19 or an early resignation from a randomly selected university, the student can take part in the recruitment for the next academic year.

PhD Students

PhD students can apply for the Erasmus+ grant on the basis of individual arrangements made with the International Relations office, after verification of the academic offer of a particular university.
