The Europe Week is designed to raise a global perspective and intercultural awareness amongst our students and to encourage them to take up an exchange within their degree. All ERASMUS+ lectures will be integrated into the modules of our 20 programmes of the business school. Our guests are welcome to offer subjects of their choice and expertise ranging from accounting, business administration, controlling, economics, finance, intercultural communication, IT, law, logistics, management, marketing, project management, tourism to name only a few.

This year we offer two options within the ERASMUS+ program:

Option A: Lecturer option (6 h of lectures + 2 h promoting your institution among students during the study abroad fair)

Option B: Curriculum development option (4 h lecturing + 4 h curriculum development)

Teaching will be scheduled from Monday morning 08 May until Friday afternoon 12 May. Curriculum development workshops will be scheduled individually after registration.

After the registration ends we will know which subjects are being offered and we will be able to match these with our requirements. We will try our best to cater for your specific needs.

For **option A** our participants are required to teach a minimum of 8 contact hours (á 45 min) in the form of lectures, seminars, case studies, projects or a combination of them. You will have the opportunity to promote your institution amongst students and colleagues during the ERASMUS+ study abroad fair. The 2 hours' time frame will be counted towards your ERASMUS+ mobility. As a result, we are kindly asking you to prepare 6 contact hours (ch) for lectures or seminars.

For **option B** our participants are required to teach a minimum of 4 contact hours (á 45 min) in the form of lectures, seminars, case studies, projects or a combination of them. And there will be additional 4 hours' workshops for curriculum development. Additionally, we would love to ask you to promote your institution amongst students and colleagues during the ERASMUS+ study abroad fair. For Option B the 2 hours' time frame cannot be counted towards your ERASMUS+ mobility.
