

## Requirements for awarding an increase in the doctoral scholarship

1. Doctoral students with outstanding achievements in scientific work during the previous academic year:

### Participation in scientific conferences (weight of 20%)

<i>Type of conference</i>		<i>Points awarded</i>
National	Delivering a presentation	2
	Poster/announcement	1
International	Delivering a presentation in a foreign language	8
	Poster/announcement in a foreign language	6
	Delivering a presentation in Polish	5
	Poster/announcement in Polish	3

**Form of confirmation:** a certificate of participation in the scientific conference from the organizer, including the form of participation, date, venue and title of the given paper, as well as the conference program and paper abstract.

Attention!

- in case of co-written presentations, the number of points is divided proportionally to the number of authors
- no points are awarded for participation in conferences without giving a presentation
- no points are awarded for participation in seminars, workshops, etc.
- no points are awarded for organizational work related to the conference
- for participation in panel discussions at conferences, half the points attributable to a presentation are awarded

### List of scientific publications - peer-reviewed only, on the basis of the paper's acceptance for publication (weight of 30%)

<i>Type of publication</i>	<i>Points awarded</i>
In a journal included on the list of ranked journals of the Polish Ministry of Science and Higher Education	according to the list
Publication in Polish in a journal not included on the list of ranked journals of the Polish Ministry of Science and Higher Education	3
Publication in a foreign language in a journal not included on the list of ranked journals of the Polish Ministry of Science and Higher Education	8
Writing a monograph or textbook in Polish	10
Writing a chapter in a monograph or textbook in Polish	5
Writing a monograph or textbook in a foreign language	20
Writing a chapter in a monograph or textbook in a foreign language	10
Publication in peer-reviewed papers of an international conference, included in the Web of Science	10

**Form of confirmation:** Photocopies of pages confirming the title of the journal/monograph/book, author's name, reviewers, publishing board, table of contents and the first page of author's article/chapter

Attention!

- scientific publication is understood as a peer-reviewed scientific paper published in a scientific journal, presenting the results of a research or research work of an empirical, theoretical, technical or analytical nature, presenting the methodology or research, the course of its process, results and conclusions - including the literature cited (bibliography)
- publications are assigned to a single year; once they are published they cannot be reported in the following year
- reported are only publications from the academic year preceding the year during which the scholarship was awarded
- reissues are not credited

- in the case of a joint authorship, the number of points is awarded in proportion to the number of authors; it is presumed that the contributions are equal
- in case of an authorship of more than one chapter in a joint publication, the sum of points obtained cannot be higher than the number of points awarded for monographs/textbooks
- a summary/abstract is not a publication
- whenever a foreign language is mentioned it refers to world languages: English, German, French, Spanish, Russian, Italian

### **Other scientific achievements (30%)**

Participation in international scientific internships (depending on duration; from 4 to 40 points)

Participation in interuniversity scientific internships (depending on duration; from 2 to 20 points)

Winning a leading place (from I to III individually, or as a team) or winning an award in scientific competitions abroad (from 4 to 20 points)

Winning a leading place (from I to III individually, or as a team) or winning an award in national scientific competitions (from 1 to 5 points)

**Form of confirmation:** diploma, certificate, etc.

### **Commitment to the conduct of scientific research (weight of 20%)**

<i>Projects</i>	<i>Points awarded</i>
Polish scientific projects such as: NCN, NCBiR, FNP, etc..	
a) participation as a supervisor	10
b) participation as a contractor	up to 10% involvement in the project - 4 points (with every additional 10% the score grows by 2 points; but no more than 10 points in total)
c) cooperation in project implementation	2
d) activity in obtaining funding for research projects	3
International scientific projects such as: Horizon 2020, Visegrad Grants	Points as awarded in Polish scientific projects, multiplied by 2
Participation in other projects, such as e.g.: ESF	2
Participation in statutory research <sup>1</sup>	2
Individual project within the framework of the so-called young scientists <sup>2</sup>	5

**Form of confirmation:** if a doctoral student is also a research supervisor: a copy of the parties to the contract (in case of project implementation) with the supervisor's name visible; if a doctoral student is a contractor: a confirmation from the project supervisor with percentage of the student's involvement in the project; a certificate from the Office of Research and Scientific Projects

Workshops conducted in Poland - points depend on the number of days (from 2 to 10 points)

Workshops conducted outside Poland - points depend on the number of days (from 4 to 20 points)

#### **Workshops must be related to the doctoral dissertation**

**Form of confirmation:** a document confirming the participation in workshop, together with a justification of the relationship between the subject of the internship/workshop and the doctoral dissertation, confirmed by the supervisor of the doctoral dissertation; please, indicate the unit responsible for sending you to the workshop
